



NTS ATLANTIC DRAMAFEST CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The NTS Atlantic DramaFest is a non-competitive, three-day drama festival held from Friday, May 17th to Sunday, May 19th 2024. This year's Festival will be held once again at Memorial University in St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador.

About the DramaFest

The purpose of the Festival is to provide a showcase for participants to demonstrate their unique theatrical work with a maximum running time of 50 minutes. Performances are adjudicated by experienced theatre professionals and workshops are offered to the students throughout the festival weekend. The Festival is open to students from Grades 9 to 12 from all four Atlantic Provinces. All school groups will be chosen by submitting a proposal by **March 1st, 2024**.

The cost per participant is \$150. This includes all workshops, meals while at the Festival, and accommodations for three nights for groups traveling outside of the St. John's area. The maximum number of participants from each school, including teachers or chaperones, is 15. All groups must include a student stage manager.

Travel expenses from schools traveling from outside Newfoundland and Labrador may be subsidized depending on funding.

Proposals must include:

- 1) A completed application form (attached)
- 2) A letter describing the proposed play/performance & the high school's drama activities/programs
- 3) A list of the students and teachers involved
