VENUE

Located on the ground floor of the Monument-National, **Le Café** has floor-to-ceiling windows that look out onto Saint-Laurent Boulevard, symbolizing its openness to Montreal's city life. It is equipped with versatile technical equipment, making it ideal for a wide range of activities – launches, conferences, intimate gatherings, shows – all in a warm, inviting atmosphere. This venue can accommodate 100 people seated or 180 in a cocktail setting.

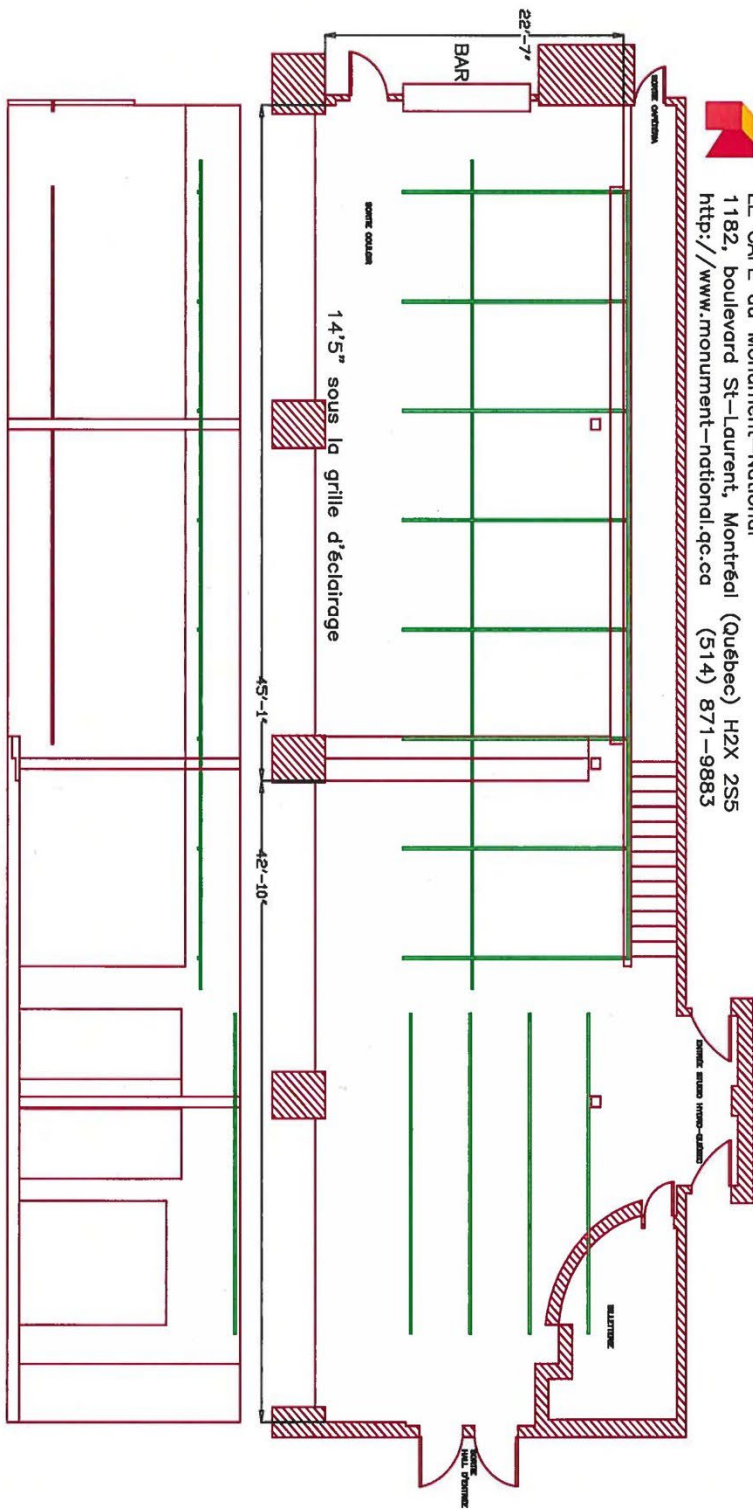

The Monument-National forms one of two campuses of the National Theatre School of Canada.

- Located near the corner of Saint-Laurent and René-Lévesque Boulevards, it is within walking distance of both the Saint-Laurent and Place-d'Armes metro stations.
- The main entrance and Box Office are located at 1182 Saint-Laurent Boulevard; The reception staff and backstage entrance is located at 1170 Saint-Laurent Boulevard.
- It was built in 1893 and entirely renovated in 1993 for its centennial anniversary.
- The Box Office is managed by the Monument-National and powered by Tuxedo (monumentnational.tuxedobillet.com).
